As parents, family members and friends of the players, we naturally will take exception to bad or missed calls by the referees. During the excitement of the play it could appear to get a little rough or the opposing teams fans may seem to be unsportsman like. We ask that you remember that this a youth sports event .

The game is played by the players on the floor not in the stands.

We will require the following conduct from all spectators

- Support your team and your player(s) in a positive way.
- The use of profanity or rude gestures towards either the opposing team, their coaches, their fans and the referees is strictly prohibited.
- Harassment of the referees could result in a technical foul on your team and/or your removal from the gym.
- You as a spectator can and will be ejected in the event your behavior is determined to be unacceptable by the referees.
- Do not chant, name call, or stomp your feet while the players are shooting free throws.....remember, these are kids!
- Win or lose, encourage your team before, during and after their game.
- Lastly, please remove all trash and deposit it as you leave the gym.
